General Rules and Conditions

- 1. **Door** The door will be kept closed during the performance of each item and no person will be allowed to enter or leave the hall while a rendition is in progress.
- 2. **Cameras/Electronic Devices/Video Cameras** it is the policy of the Ingham Arts Festival Association Inc. that cameras, electronic devices and video cameras are prohibited in the venues, with the exception of the official photographer/press photographer.
- 3. **Detailed Adjudication Slips** Adjudication slips can be collected from venues at the conclusion of each section. One adjudication slip is provided, free of charge, for each item in all performance sections.
- 4. **Tuning of Instruments** Tuning of instruments, practice of instruments and voice warming is not allowed in the theatre or back-stage, or in the close vicinity of the hall at any time during the competition. Instruments which need to tune to the piano may do so momentarily prior to the section.
- 5. **Props/Backstage** Under no circumstances will any unauthorised person be allowed back-stage without the permission of the Committee. Any hand props must be the responsibility of the competitor. Please show respect for the stage in regard to props, which must not be dragged along. NO foreign substance is to be spilt on the stage.
- 6. Arrival Time As there can often be unexpected withdrawals during a session, it would be prudent of competitors to arrive ready to perform at least half an hour before expected time of their section. Competitors must be ready to perform before the section starts.
- 7. **Impromptu and Improvisation Sections** All competitors in such sections are to report to the Marshal BEFORE this section begins. Failure to appear before the commencement of that particular section will mean the disqualification of such competitor.
- 8. Adjudicators Any approach to an adjudicator by an entrant, parent, teacher or friend of the competitor during the Festival is not allowed.
- 9. **Licensing** The Ingham Arts Festival Association Inc. is covered by licence from the Australasian Performing Rights Association under Section "Q". Competitors and teachers are warned about Copyright Laws. Copies for the purpose of adjudication are allowed as "temporary" copies only.
- 10. **"Quiet Please"** The audience is required to maintain absolute silence during the rendition of each item and also to refrain from applauding until the competitor is definitely finished. Your cooperation will be very much appreciated.
- 11. **Coaching of Competitors** Adjudicators are aware of parents/family coaching competitors during the performance. This detracts from the rendition, in that the performer is not performing to the audience as required.
